



## ADMISSION & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

As per Government of Haryana, INC, HNRC & Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences Rohtak

1. **B.Sc. Nursing** : Bachelor of Science in nursing shall be of four academic years (8 semesters) after 10+2 with medical subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology).
  - The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
  - Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually.
  - Candidate shall be medically fit.
  - Selection of candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination.
  - Minimum qualifying marks for entrance test shall be 50% marks & Test shall be conducted by University/State Government.
  - Admission would be done after successful document verification at university.
2. **Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing** : Bachelor of Science in Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing shall be of two academic years after GNM.
  - Candidate should have passed 10+2 & Midwifery (GNM) passing with State Nursing Council with RN & RM Number.
  - Candidate shall be medically fit.
  - Selection of candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination.
  - Minimum qualifying marks for entrance test shall be 50% marks & Test shall be conducted by University/State Government.
  - Admission would be done after successful document verification at university.
3. **GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery)** : General Nursing and Midwifery shall be of Three years after 10+2 in any stream.
  - Minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31st December of that year) The upper age limit is 35 yrs.
  - Admission of students shall be once in a year.
  - Student must be medically fit.
  - Registered ANM with pass mark.
  - 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre
  - 5% of total marks is relaxed for SC/ST candidates
  - 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.

## Examination Scheme

**The candidate shall appear for exams in each semester as per university norms :**

- i. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each course/subject for appearing for examination.
- ii. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.
- iii. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
- iv. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical, he/she has to re-appear for both the papers (Theory and Practical)



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- v. The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for fifth semester examination. However, the candidates shall be permitted to attend the consecutive semesters.
- vi. The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examinations before appearing for seventh semester examination. However, the candidates shall be permitted to attend the consecutive semesters.
- vii. The candidate shall have cleared all the previous examination before appearing for final year examination.
- viii. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 8 years.

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

The application form duly completed in the candidates own handwriting, should reach the admission office of the association on or before \_\_\_\_\_. It may be either submitted personally or sent under registered post. Incomplete application form or those received after the closing date will not be considered. The competent authority takes no responsibility for any postal delay in the receipt or loss of application in transit.

The application form must be accompanied by attested photocopies of:

1. Four attested photocopies of matriculation certificate.
2. Four attested photocopies of 10+2 certificate.
3. Two attested photocopies of character certificate.
4. Two attested photocopies of the SC/BC certificate, if applicable.
5. Six passport size photocopies.
6. Recent medical fitness by an M.B.B.S. doctor on Govt. service.
7. Aadhaar card copy-1.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The cost of prospectus-cum-application form will not be refunded under any circumstance.
2. Any attempt on the part of a candidate, his parents or relatives to canvass or influence to beat upon the competent authority, directly for securing admission will lead to disqualification.
3. The candidate is admitted on the basis of information submitted by him/her and if, at any subsequent stage, it is discovered that any portion of this information is incorrect the student will be rusticated from the institute and all fees and other dues paid/liable to be paid up till the date of such candidate shall be forfeited/charges. Any further action, as deemed suitable, may also be taken by the institution against such student.
4. The application form should be filled carefully in block and legible letters and signed by the candidate. All claims made in the application must be supported with documentary proof, application which are incomplete must be supported with documentary proof. Application which are incomplete in respect of the required particulars of back the essential documents will be rejected.
5. In case of any ambiguity in the rules the interpretation by the chairman, State admission Committee shall be final.
6. A student who violates the above conditions wilfully or otherwise shall be liable to face expulsion.
7. Instructions/direction to modify/change the condition can be issued by the association prior to counselling with the prior approval of the state admission committee.
8. Objection, if any, about the contents/conditions of the eligibility mentioned in the prospectus can be raised in the form of a representation to the competent authority before the invitation of counselling.

**Note :** The candidates if fail in more than one/two subjects in any nursing programme they can be promoted to next year. Only two attempts were allowed before 2012, now a candidate can take any number of attempts. With a condition that the maximum period allowed is as prescribed for each nursing programme, that is Post basic B.Sc. (N)-4 years and B.Sc. (N)-8 years. However, all papers need to be cleared before appearing in the final examination.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL & COLLEGE

1. Once admission is confirmed, no fee will be refunded. Further any student leaving the course in the middle of the session will be required to deposit whole course fee before N.O.C. is given.
2. All the students must be punctual in classroom and clinical area. In case of sickness apply for leave before the class/duty time.
3. Students will have P.T.S. exam after 3 months, which must be cleared, otherwise student may be sent back to their home.
4. Students are not allowed to have visitors in the clinical area.
5. Students are responsible to pay the examination fees, and conveyance charges to and from the examination centre and student only collect the admit card from institute before date of examination otherwise management will not responsible for their exam.
6. Students will also bear the expenses if sent for learning experiences to other teaching centre.
7. Students must take active part in extra-curricular activities.
8. **FEES:** Payment of monthly fee should be made before the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. The late depositors will have to pay fine of Rs. 10/- per day.
9. Annual fee will be payable by the students at the time of the admission
10. University fees as well as the examination fee and other funds will be charges from the student on an annual basis. Fee & funds are subject to change as per university & Haryana govt. rules.
11. Ward incharges, health centre incharges and instructors will have the authority to maintain strict discipline in college & clinical areas.
12. Students will not be allowed for marriage/engagement during the training time.
13. Students must pay cash for all purchases from market or local shops.
14. Intimacy with the male & female persons in the hospitals and outside will be viewed seriously, which if not stopped may result in termination of training.
15. Students are forbidden to accept gifts (in kind of money) from the patients or their relatives.
16. **Uniform:** All the trainees will be required to wear approved uniform while on duty and in classroom.
17. **Books:** Textbooks recommended by Dr. Jai Prakash Memorial School of nursing will be made available to the students on payment of current cost.
18. **Vacation:** Vacations will be given according to the rules of the Indian Nursing Council at the time when it does not interfere with school programme. If any student does not return from vacation on time, will be disciplined by imposing fine, cutting days off or both.
19. Request for leave on telephone or through telegram will not be accepted, parent should come to discuss the matter personally or else send a letter signed by parent through some relatives. (It is for safety and security of the students).
20. **Sick leave:** Only 10 day's sick leave per annum is granted if medical certificate of MBBS doctor of the Govt. dispensary or hospital is produced. Excess days of leave with doing extra duties.
21. Sick students are required to report to the concerned faculty at any time. The warden is responsible for arranging first aid necessary and takes them to the hospital.
22. Repeated misbehaviour, violation of rules, refusal from duty, poor performance in theory & practical, and joining or instigating for strike will call for strict disciplinary action resulting in expulsion from the school without any claim.
23. If class attendance fails below 80% & clinical attendance 100% the student will not be allowed to sit in the examination.
24. Participation in extra-curricular activities is compulsory.
25. Students will not be allowed to appear in any Board or University examination anu private & Govt. job during the training period.
26. Hostel is compulsory for all admitted students as per INC/UHSR norms.



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## HOSTEL RULES

1. Students are not allowed to keep large sum of cash, jewellery or other valuables in their rooms. The institution shall be not responsible for any theft.
2. The rooms can be checked by the warden or any competent authority at any time of the day and night to check for cleanliness and occupancy.
3. Electrical appliances for any kind forbidden in the hostel and campus. In case of default a fine of rupees 500/- will be imposed, beside confiscation of the concerned gazettes.
4. The furniture and any setting or fittings in the hostel must be kept intact. Any damage to it will be charged from defaulters.
5. Economy of electricity and water must be practiced. Fans and lights as well as taps are to be switched off when not in use.
6. Alcohol, Drugs and smoking are not permitted to meet them ward in hostel. However, they will meet them in visitor room.
7. Relatives of students including parents are not permitted to meet their ward in the hostel. However they will meet them in visitor's room.
8. Facilities for ironing of clothes have been provided by the management in the hostel. Payment for the same should be made before the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month.
9. Action will be taken against any student defying rules and regulations of the institute. Management reserves the rights to expel such a student.

## LEAVE RULES

1. Students required leave to visit their home for any purpose such as family event or any emergency need to get written permission from their parents for sanctioning of the same by the principal.
2. Students not returning from leave in the time are liable to be subjected to disciplinary action beside imposing a fine of Rs. 100/- per day. They will have to do additional duties to make up compensation for the period of absence.
3. Student falling sick while on leave must bring a medical certificate from a qualified doctor specially mentioned diagnosis and treatment.

## OUTINGS

1. Students are allowed to go for outing visit Yamuna-Nagar town once in a month in groups after obtaining permission from the warden and respective principal.
2. For the purpose the students shall be going in the institute bus on payment basis and must come back to the hostel in the same vehicle. Defaulters will be punished.

## STUDENT'S NURSE ASSOCIATION

Membership of student nurse association should be compulsory at institutional and national level. The students are encouraged to participate in professional. Social and cultural activities at the state and national level. Various competitions, Exhibitions and conferences are organised by the association which provide the students an opportunity to learn and gain various experiences for the growth and development of professional abilities.

### ANTI RAGGING ACT

The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgment dated 8<sup>th</sup> May 2009 in civil petition no. 887, 2008 in the matter of committee on ragging and on institution regulations. The college has authority to punish the students and take action on ragging is available at the website www.education.nic.in. The college has authority to punish the student and take action on ragging as per rule according to Hon'ble Supreme Court. The anti ragging committee fine the students Rs. 5000/- per head as per rule of the institution. Counselling should be done for both seniors and fresher's by a professional counsellor organisation on a large scale of cultural, sports and other activities to provide a platform for the fresher's and seniors to interact in the presence of faculty members. Every institution must have an anti-ragging committee. The ragging is totally prohibited in the institution.
